## **REVIEW OF COMMUNITY BUILDINGS SURVEY 2022**

Following Regulation 14 some adjustments have been made to the list in CL1. Some have been added, others deleted. Where it wasn't clear that facilities were available for community groups to meet, they were re-contacted and the information up-dated. Gyms and soft play centres remain in the list owing to their value as places for enhancing well-being, regardless of extra facilities.

Pubs are included for their intrinsic role as regular social meeting places. Pubs "play a key role in facilitating friendships and that those who have a local pub are happier, more trusting and better connected to their community" (Research by CAMRA 2016)

Pubs were contacted for up-to-date information on specific groups meeting at those premises. Changes from the original survey were identified as follows:
